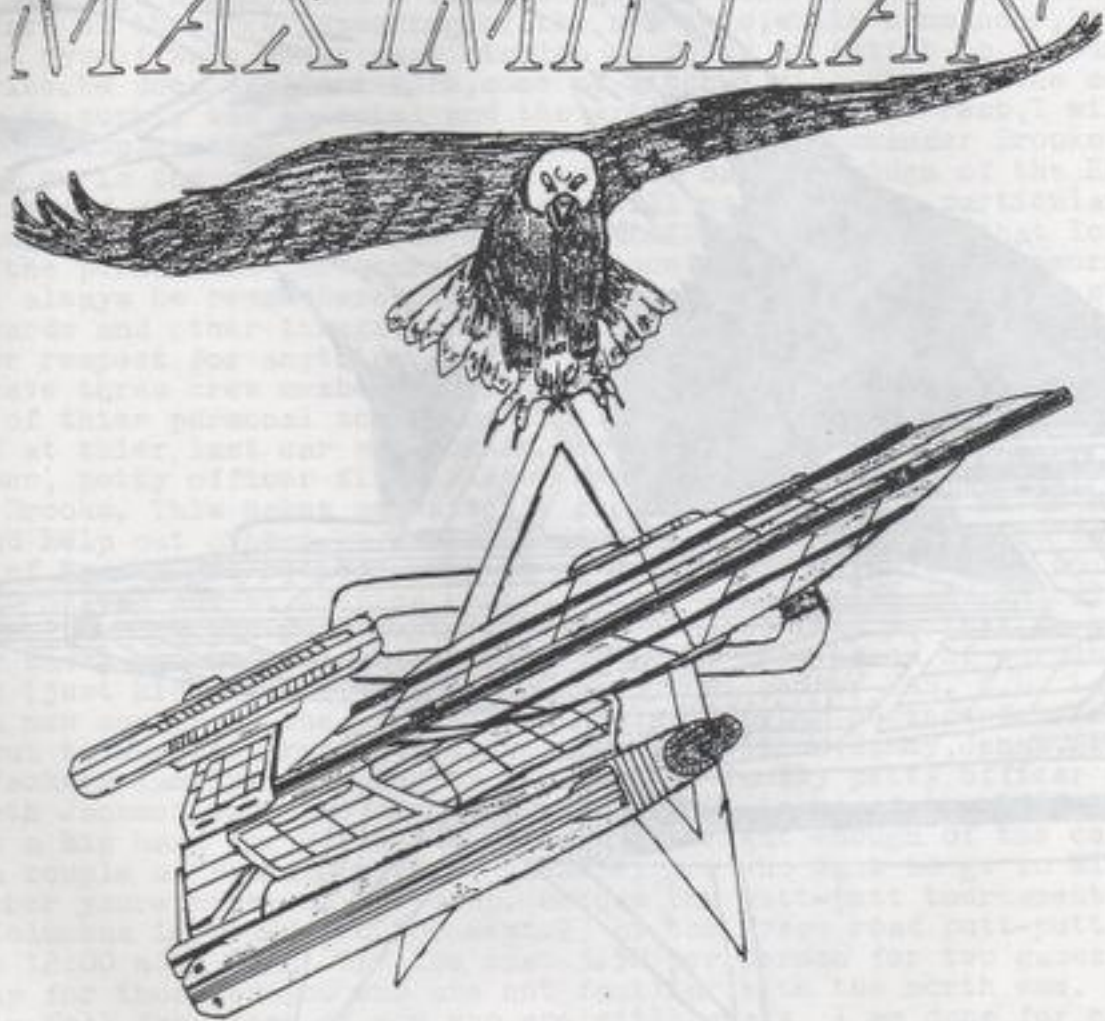

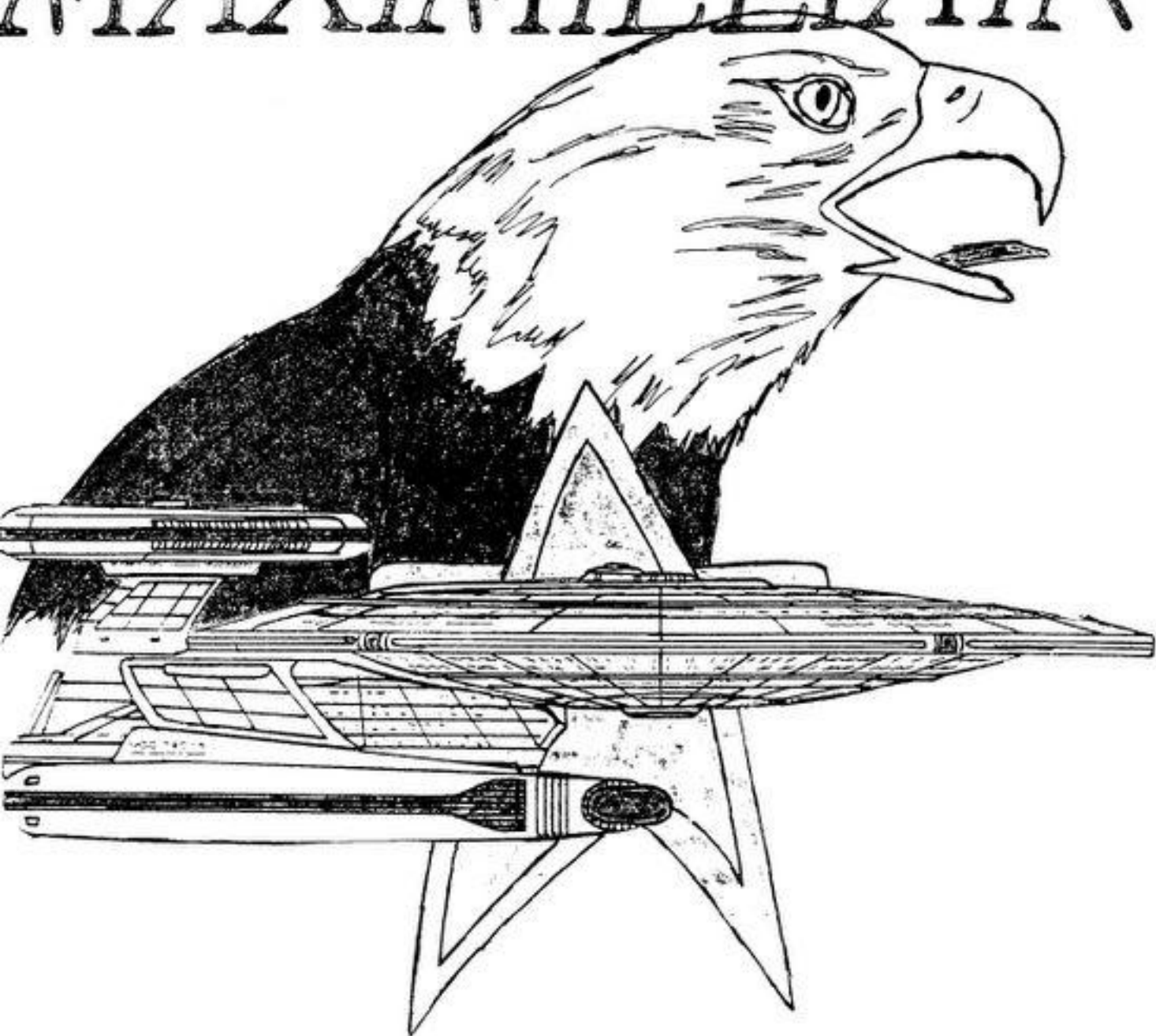

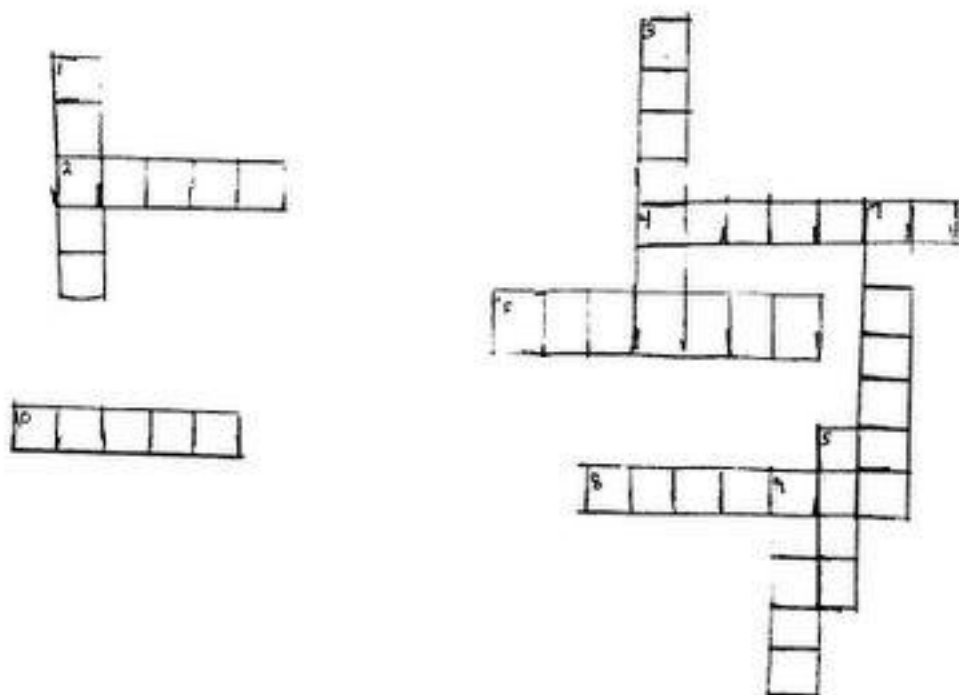

-an old earth saying is brought up(two sips if Data has to have it explained to him.)

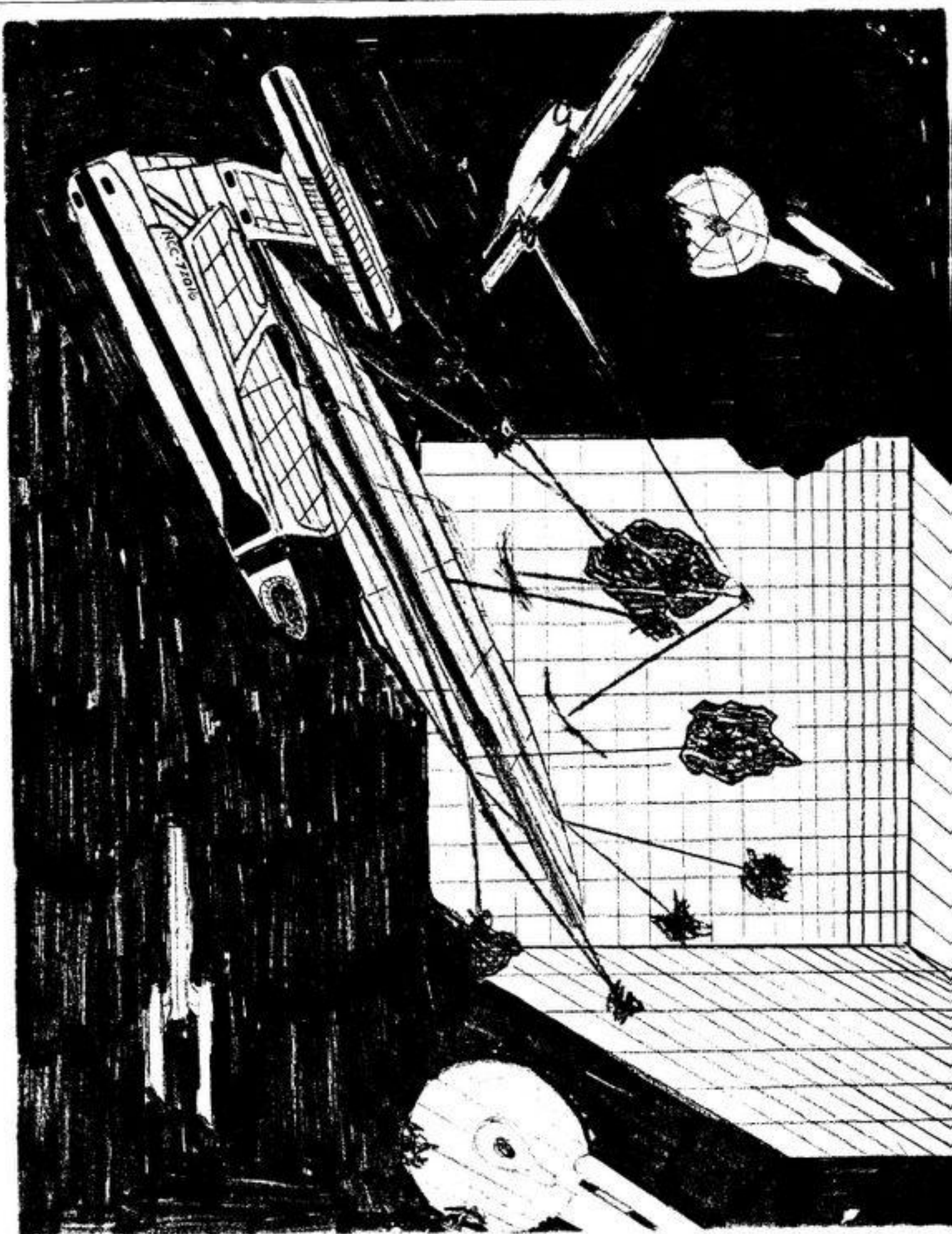
-Klingon is spoken,(two sips if per scene in which Klingons are alone and have no obvious reason to speak English-but do so anyway.

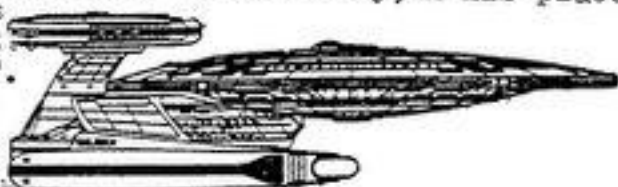
